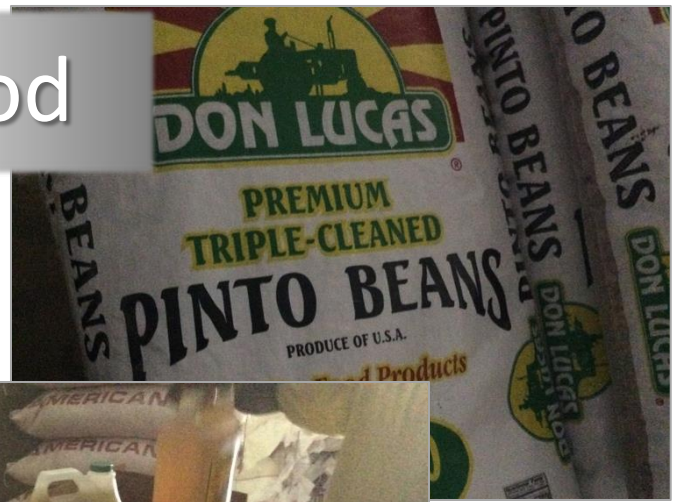

The church has been growing in attendance, both with children coming to Sunday School and adults attending the Sunday morning worship service. Several members of the congregation accepted Jesus as their Savior and were baptized after completing a course that Pastor Ellie taught on what it means to be a follower of Jesus. The Sunday



School class is growing and our boys are helping Pastor Ellie's daughter teach each week.



Our adult literacy class has grown to over 50 adults, who are mostly mothers and fathers of our school children. They come early to class and are very eager to learn. We currently have two classes: one for those who cannot read or write and



a second class for those who have some reading and writing skills. As part of their learning, we are teaching them about Jesus and how to read the Bible. We plan to give each adult student a Bible when they finish their studies.



Finally, we thank you for your sponsorship of our school children. As of this writing, all 136 students are sponsored.
